

BELLEVUE PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD MEETING

Tuesday June 16, 2026 – 5:30 P.M.

The Bellevue Public Library Board met on Tuesday, June 16, 2026 at 5:30 P.M. with President Curt Zeimet presiding.

The roll was called as follows: Present: Board members Katie Ohlert, Myia Steines, Ann Bernhard Hoff, Curt Zeimet, Linda Nudd, and Judy Manning. Also present was Michael Burris, current Director and Secretary. Heather Wood was not present and excused.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

President Zeimet asked the Board for any additions, deletions, or corrections to the agenda. A motion to approve the agenda was made by Bernhard Hoff and seconded by Steines. Unanimously approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

After reading the minutes of the previous meeting, President Zeimet asked for any additions or corrections to the minutes of May 19, 2026. A motion was made by Nudd and seconded by Manning to approve the minutes. Unanimously approved.

CORRESPONDENCE

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Summer Reading Program is doing well and on track. The library collections are being rearranged for better access by the public. Some STEM kits are being removed for lack of interest and will be replaced with family accessible games – that also support developing STEM skills. The altered work hours for Trish are working out at the moment, evaluation is ongoing.

FINANCIAL REPORT AND APPROVAL OF BILLS

The Director presented the library bills for the month of May 2026. A motion to approve the Director's Report, library reports and the bills was made by Steines and seconded by Ohlert and was unanimously approved.
